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



What do we mean by Self-Regulation?



DOE's version:

Self-Regulation (SR) is our Objective/ Goal/ Target/ Final Destination to achieve in building up environmental culture in society and regulated communities/ sectors

How to achieve Self-Regulation (SR)?

To achieve the target of SR, we need to embrace Environmental Mainstreaming Tools to all levels of regulated communities

What is Environmental Mainstreaming (EM)?

EM is a tool for accomplishing the goal of cultivating the self-regulation culture in the regulated sectors.

EM refers to the integration of environmental concerns, aspects, and considerations in all business processes, at all stages of decision making, at all levels of organizational hierarchy, and at all phases of the operation of a development project or a manufacturing industry.

Through EM the manufacturing company owner is shouldered with greater environmental responsibility and accountability for ensuring environmental friendly options are chosen in the course of operation of his project or manufacturing facility.







How do we facilitate the regulated sectors towards compliance?

DOE facilitates towards compliance through certification program



Teach them to understand the law,

Teach them sampling criteria and plan (Sampling type, location and Frequency)



Teach them how to analyze and interpret data



Teach them how to keep records, etc



Teach them how to do reporting (to CEO & DOE)

Just compound them, or take them to court, or issue a prohibition order!




