# The Conference

The Incorporated Society of Planters (ISP), will be organising the 10th International Planters Conference on 12 - 14 June 2023 at Royale Chulan Kuala Lumpur, after a very successful ISP National Seminar in 2022.

With the opening of the borders, lifting of Covid-19 pandemic restrictions, global economic recovery and average palm oil prices, we are expecting overwhelming response from local and foreign participants. We are sure that this Conference will be bigger, better and more exciting than ever before. We are proud to announce that Malaysian Palm Oil Council (MPOC) has partnered with ISP in this Conference to present papers on promotion and marketing.

Oil palm is one of the major players in the agriculture sector at national and global economy. It has played a significant role in improving food security and meeting the demands for fuels and fibre. 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# Call For Poster

The Conference programme will include a poster session to provide a platform to planters, scientists, researchers, postgraduate and undergraduate students to share their research and observations in order to obtain feedback through interaction with local and international participants.

The poster papers should relate to the palm oil industry covering any of the following main topics:

- i. Business Strategies
  - Plantation Management, Plantation Enterprise Competition.
- ii. Innovation and Technology
  - Palm Oil By-products, Narrowing Performance Gap, Automation and Mechanisation Issues.
- iii. Promotion and Marketing
- iv. ESG and Sustainability
  - Contribution of Palm Oil to SDG Goals, Forced Labour Issues, EU's Green Deal Proposal

The Conference Organising Committee invites authors to submit their extended summary in English of not less than 500 words before 15 December 2022 to: [stmalar@isp.org.my](mailto:stmalar@isp.org.my). A selection committee will review the poster papers and notification of acceptance will be forwarded to successful authors. The successful authors will then have to submit a "full paper" by 15 April 2023 following the guidelines which will be given.

Each poster will be on display throughout the period of the Conference. Authors presenting poster papers will be required to be in attendance at their poster stand during the time allotted. Allocated time will be during the Conference tea breaks. Thereafter, the authors will be invited to join the Q&A session to answer any queries from participants with respect to the subject matter presented.

## **Poster template**

**The size of the poster display is 91.4 cm (3 ft. - W) x 121.9 cm (4 ft. - H)**

The presentations are an integral part of the Conference and therefore due care must be exercised to ensure high quality presentation.

- Contents of a poster presentation.

The poster will usually have a title (72 point size), name, affiliation, contact information of the presenter(s) besides introduction, results, discussion and conclusion.

- The introduction should be brief but provide sufficient information to understand the purpose of the study.
- Discussion and results can be limited to a few key findings to validate the conclusions
- Section headings should be at least 36 point size.

## **Layout of a poster presentation**

- A poster presentation will only have a good impact if it is well designed.
- All letterings of titles should be large enough to catch a reader's attention. Letterings of the text should be large enough to be easily read from a distance of 1.5 m. Use bulleted lists where possible instead of paragraphs. Use italics instead of underlining, or black lettering instead of a light coloured rectangle. The text should be concise enough to be read in less than 10 minutes.
- There should be a limited number of items in a table. Graphic illustrations such as figures, concise tables, diagrams, photographs, and maps should be clearly labelled with a brief title.
- There should be simple links between tables, illustrations and text.
- Use tack-and-stick reusable adhesive, mounting tabs or tape to attach materials to the boards provided.

## **Paper for publication**

Authors are required to submit a full paper for publication in the Conference proceedings.

## **Conference Registration Fee**

Successful authors have to register as participants and pay the normal registration fees and attend all the sessions of the Conference.

## **Best Poster Award**

Awards will be given to poster papers, which display high quality in presenting new ideas and concepts in line with the theme of the Conference. The best selected posters will be rewarded as follows:

**1<sup>st</sup> prize – RM3,000 | 2<sup>nd</sup> prize – RM2,000 | 3<sup>rd</sup> prize – RM1,000**

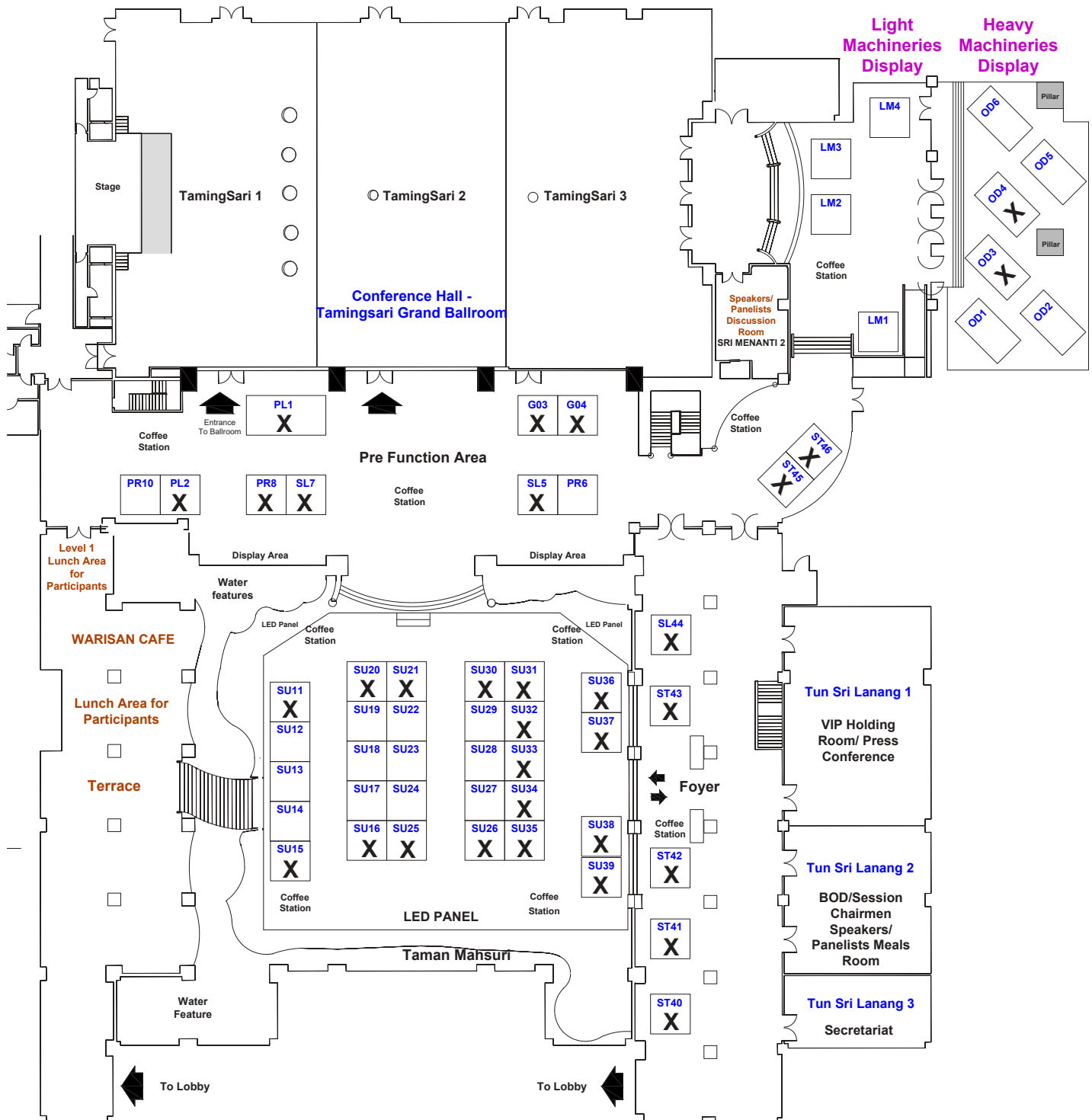
